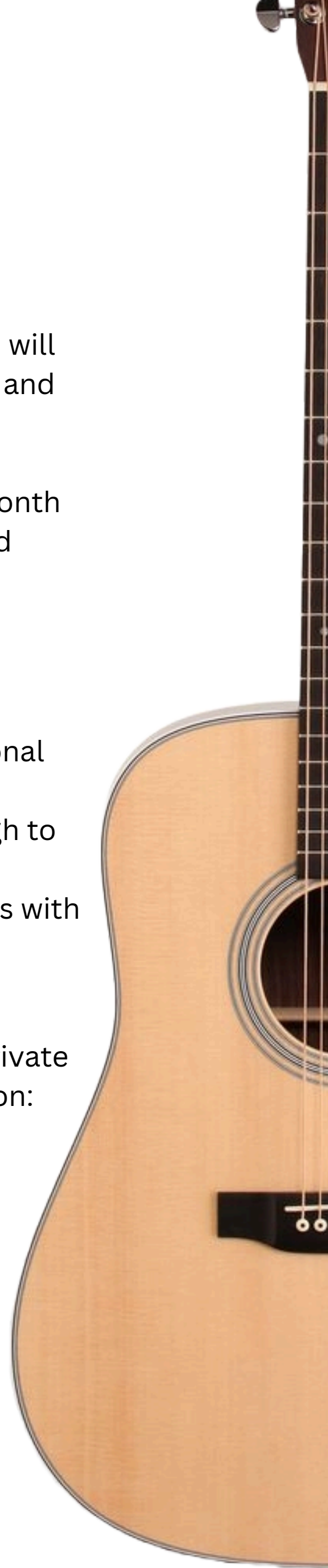

**What age is this course ideal for?**

**GHA Response**

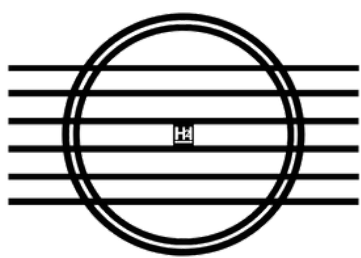
